RING SIZE GUIDE

- The most reliable and efficient way to find out your ring size is to visit a jewelry store and ask to measure your fingers or a ring you are wearing at the moment.
- All household methods of determining a ring size are not 100% accurate. It is important to remember that the ring must pass over the knuckle. The size of the finger may vary depending on the time of day, climate conditions, and general physical condition.
- A wide ring will fit your finger tighter than a narrow band.
- Your right-hand and left-hand fingers are a different size and thickness.

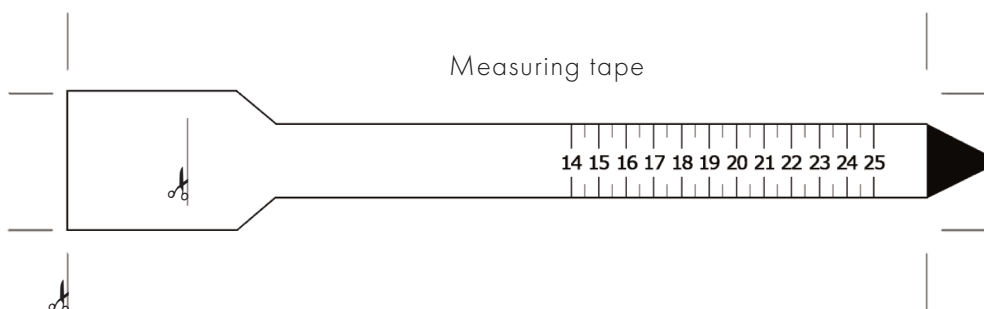
PRINTING SETTINGS

- Go to "printing settings" and ensure that "page scaling" is set to "NONE or 100%"
- Take a ruler and measure the sample below. It should measure exactly 2 cm.



WAY Nº 1

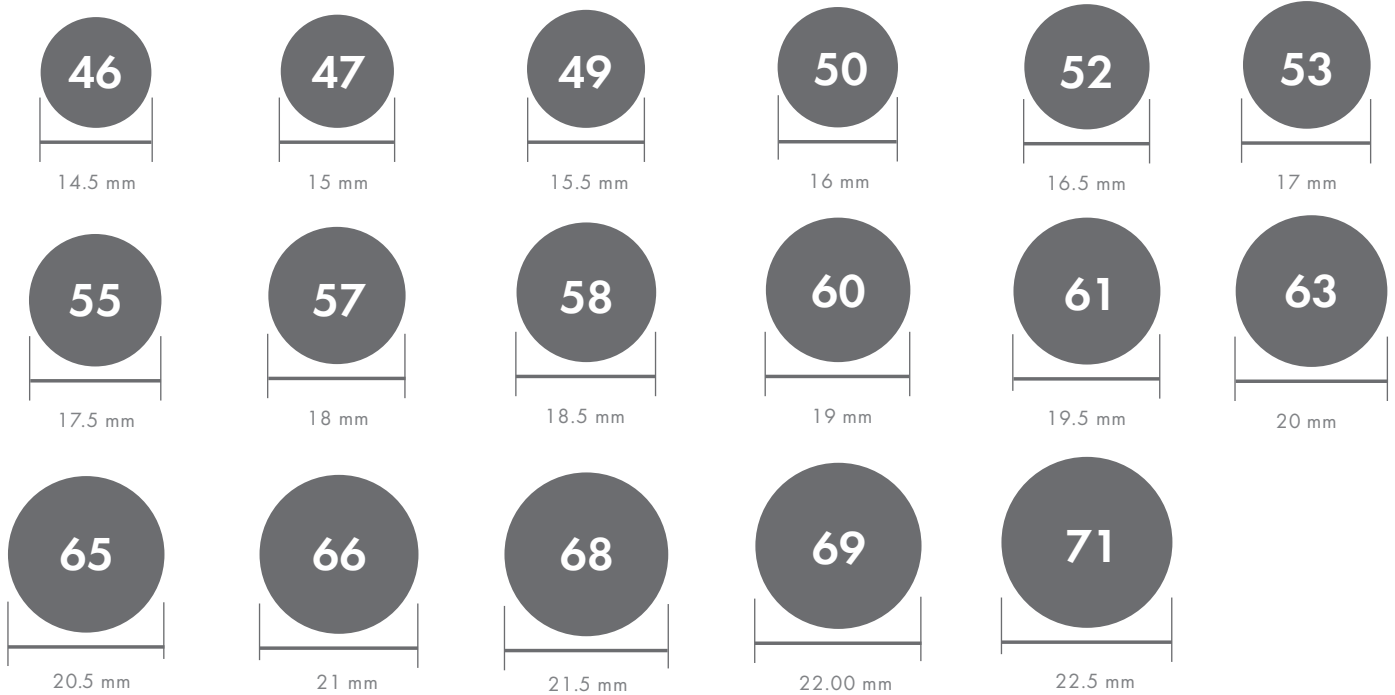
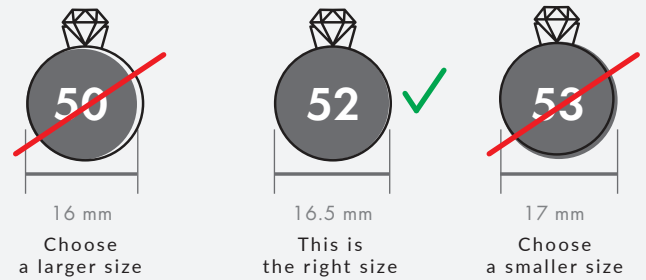
- Cut the pattern.
- Wrap the tape around your finger.
- The label on which you stopped is your size



WAY Nº2

- Place the ring over the circle.
- The edges of the circle must be aligned with the edges of the ring.
- If your ring is between two sizes, choose the larger size.
